Info About Changing Your Best Mountain Bikes Tires

If you need to change the tires on your bike then here you will see a few tips to help you.

The first thing to replacing and fixing for example tubeless MTB tires is to remove it. Different mountain bikes require different methods to remove an old tire. If you are dealing with a fairly new mountain bike then there should be a lever on every axle on the bike. Simply pull that lever and it must automatically loosen up the tire. Older mountain bikes nevertheless are a little more difficult. If you are dealing with an old mountain bike then you have to use a wrench to loosen up the axle nuts. Only once all the nuts are loose you can then remove the tire.

When you have managed to get the tire off the bike, you should ideally let the air out of it so that you can get to the inward tube. You are going to remove the tube and to do that you will need a few mountain bike tools to help you. You need to get the tire away from the edge and to do that you need to pry at it. Be extra careful not to damage the tube while you are taking this step.

When the old tire has been removed from the mountain bike, it is then time to install the new one. Place the tire onto the rim of the bike. This may sound simple but it can be really difficult if you do not take notice of what you are doing. You may need some tools to help you a little but always ensure that you are very careful not to damage the inner tube. If you do end up damaging the inner tube you will have to go through the whole process again. Not only is that a lot of additional hassle, but it is also a waste of money. So always make sure that you are careful in every aspect of changing your bikes tire.

Overall changing even the best MTB tires is not as difficult as you may first imagine. You just must be careful whilst you are doing it.
